

## RAM and SAP Information



### **This is a summary of how Rotokare Scenic Reserve provides a safe learning environment.**

- All visiting groups to Rotokare are given a short Health and Safety talk on arrival.
- As a place of employment, Rotokare Scenic Reserve Trust is required to be fully compliant with occupational health and safety requirements (Health and Safety - employment regulations, 1995).
- The buildings at Rotokare meet the South Taranaki District Council requirements for health, safety and hygiene.
- SAP and RAM forms and procedures have been developed in relation to the environmental education programme at Rotokare, and follow the education outside the classroom guidelines set by the Ministry of Education. These are available for download on our website.
- The onsite educator and site manager hold current first aid certificates and carry a first aid kit at all times, with a permanent kit situated in the trust buildings.
- There is no mobile phone reception at Rotokare; telecom reception is often available at the top gates. However, there is a landline available in the education centre.
- There are alternative emergency exits out of the predator proof fence in the case of the main gates malfunctioning.
